D8	Biological treatment not specified elsewhere in this Annex which results in final compounds or mixtures which are discarded by means of any of the operations numbered D1 to D12
D9	Physico-chemical treatment not specified elsewhere in this Annex which results in final compounds or mixtures which are discarded by means of any of the operations numbered D1 to D12 (e.g. evaporation, drying, calcination, etc.)
D10	Incineration on land
D11	Incineration at sea
D12	Permanent storage (e.g. emplacement of containers in a mine, etc.)
D13	Blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D12
D14	Repackaging prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D13
D15	Storage pending any of the operations numbered D1 to D14

Documents to attach

- A recent copy of the criminal records or a certificate of good conduct of the individuals concerned.
- A recent excerpt from the Registry of Commerce and Companies or an equivalent body.
- A certificate of the general liability insurance policy for damages to the environment, including damages caused by the loading/unloading of the vehicle.
- (An) acceptance certificate(s) signed by the primary recipient(s) of the waste mentioned in Annex 2A.
- A copy of the operating licence of the primary recipient mentioned in Annex 2A and, where applicable, of the secondary recipient(s) mentioned in Annex 2B (apart from recipients located in Luxembourg).
- **Applicants are allowed to submit copies of the documents that they must attach. However, for the following documents, the original or a certified copy must be submitted:**
 - **the criminal records / certificates of good conduct;**
 - **an acceptance certificate signed by the recipient of the waste;**
 - **any other document issued by the competent authority of a country that is not a member of the European Union.**

The documents that you need to attach to this application form must be written in one of the following languages: Luxembourgish, French, or German. Any document written in another language shall be rejected, unless a translation is provided. **For documents issued by the competent authority of a country that is not a member of the European Union, you must attach a certified translation.**

Column 2 of Annex 1 "EWC waste code" must indicate the waste code. Only the six-digit codes of the European Waste Catalogue (EWC) are allowed. However, the codes ending in '99' may only be used if there is no more appropriate code. If a code ending in '99' is indicated, the exact name of the waste (not the description of the EWC) must be indicated in column 3. If no other code is more appropriate, the code ending in '99' shall be reserved for the name indicated in column 3.
