



Access Guide to the Luxembourg CBAM Portal

This guide explains how to access the CBAM register in the final phase, also known as the AMM (Authorisation Management Module). This access enables two main actions:

- Apply for and manage a CBAM authorisation. This authorisation is required to import more than 50 tonnes of CBAM goods.
- Monitor CBAM imports made by your company. The register shows all CBAM imports in aggregated or detailed form for tracking purposes.

Regarding the application itself:

- Access may be requested by any company importing CBAM goods that currently imports or plans to import such goods.
- We recommend access to any company that imports at least 30 tonnes per year on average.
- As long as the threshold of 50 tonnes per year is not exceeded, authorization is not required, but it must be requested before the threshold is exceeded.
- Any application made before 31 March 2026 may use the application number as a derogation until the application has been processed. An application number obtained after this date cannot be used for the derogation.

The application must be made by the company to which the [importer's EORI number](#) belongs. If the customs representative handling the clearance of the goods offers a CBAM service, they can provide their own authorisation number. Please contact your customs representative first to see if a CBAM service is provided.

The registration process is the same for both importers and customs representatives. The only difference in the register relates to the authorisation application, [which is described here](#).

First, you must create an EU-Login account:

Once the account has been created, you must note down the 8-character UID (Unique Identifier at the Commission). Example: n00ew4xx

This information can also be found by clicking on the cog icon on the right -> My Account -> My Account Details.


Please complete [this form](#) if you are a third party offering a CBAM service. Your profile will be linked to that of an importer via delegation. The delegation process is described in the second part of this guide.

Complete the forms and follow the instructions.

Once we have received the electronic file with an electronic signature or the physical letter, we will validate your access to the register. Confirmation will be sent to the email address you provided in the form. You will then be able to test your access.

Note: This configuration does not work for third-party applications. Please refer to the last page of the guide for the correct configuration.

There is no need to press the “VALIDATE” button on the ID. After authentication via the EU login, you will be taken to the registry.

Transitional CBAM registry

The Commission has developed the CBAM transitional registry to help importers perform and report as part of their CBAM obligations. Access to the registry should be requested through the National Competent Authority (NCA) of the Member State in which the importer is established.

Add additional employees (Delegation-system)

To add an additional employee, please complete the attached template (Access to the CBAM portal as an additional employee) and send it to the following address:

We currently accept a maximum of 2 persons to be added via delegation. Indirect customs representatives can request more accesses if the workload is high.

To do this, first send us the completed employee template by post. No further information will be required, as the responsibility to verify the identity of the persons you grant access on your behalf lies with you. This also applies to employees of a company providing a CBAM service that has not carried out customs clearance (third party).

We will create the profile on the registry and inform you by e-mail reply.

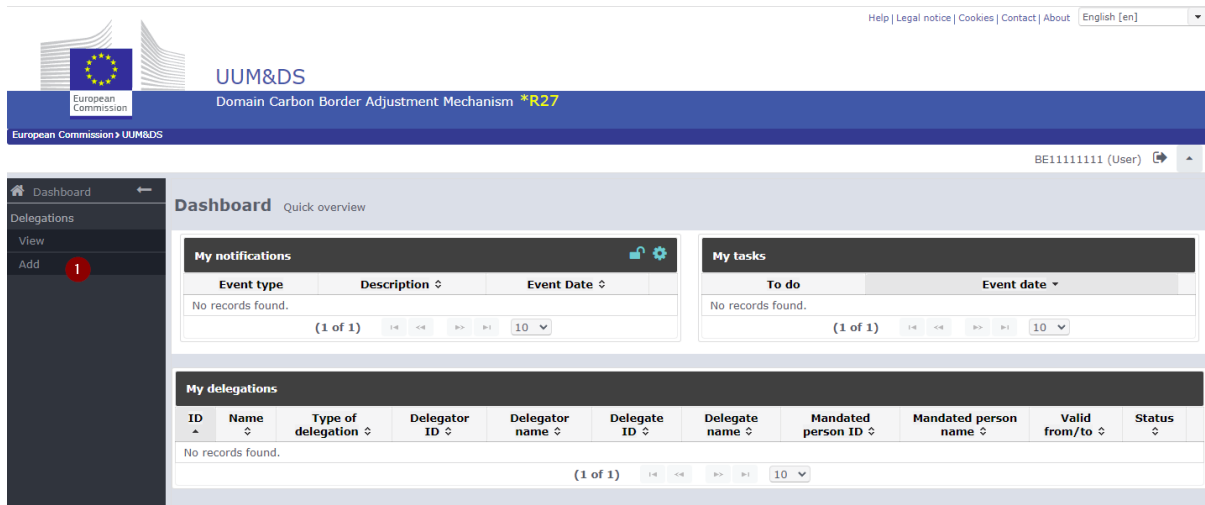

You need to connect with your EU-Login. The page you arrive at is as follows:



Press the Add button (1) to begin delegation.

Enter the information in the boxes in the following order:

1. The first 5 boxes (1-5) must always contain the information shown in the image, including:
 - > "Delegation to empl" (1),
 - > "Standard" (2),
 - > "Direct" (3),
 - > "No delegation of certificate" (4) and
 - > "All" (5).
2. In description, indicate the employee's function (6).
3. You can define the validity period yourself (7-8).
4. Press Select a business profile (9). Select CBAM_DECLARANT.
5. Then press + (10). Make sure that "CBAM Application" is in the right-hand box.
6. Press the green "Generate retrieve criterion" button (11) to receive a one-time code. Give it to the employee you are adding to the register.
