
Request for individual EPR-approval for companies subject to the Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) system

Producers/distributors of

- non-household electrical and electronic equipment (EEE-B2B)
- automotive and industrial batteries/accumulators

must comply with the Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) system by requesting an individual approval from the Minister of Environment, Climate and Biodiversity. The request must be made online through the electronic application e-RA https://www.aev.etat.lu/e_ra.php by following the steps below:

- In order to obtain your connection data for e-RA, please complete the form (available on the entry page of the electronic application) and return it to by email to the address: e_RA@aev.etat.lu
- After obtaining your login, please log in to the e-RA application e-RA.



You are directed to the page "001 – Company authorizations" page.

Depending on the category for which you plan to request an individual approval, you must select one of the following three options (only one request at a time!):

- o Application for approval @ approval EPR-BATT (individual)
- o Application for approval @ approval EPR-WEEE (individual)
- o Application for approval @ partial approval EPR-WEEE (Ecotrel WEEE-B2B members)

AND tick the name of your company

AND click on the INQ_NEW box to confirm your choice.

- You are then directed to the page "060N Administrative inquiry for Authorization / Registration / Change of Address / Change of Company Name" which confirms your choice of approach. Please click on the CONTINUE box to proceed with your request for individual approval.
- ➤ On page "060N Administrative inquiry for Authorization / Registration / Change of Address / Change of Company Name" you must complete and attach the documents listed before transferring your request.

PLEASE NOTE: the system only authorizes the transfer of the application if all mandatory documents are completed and attached! (documents in dark green are mandatory, those in light green are optional)

The process is in ENCODAGE mode until TRANSFER and you can modify/add documents at any time. As soon as all the documents are completed and attached, the TRANSFER box becomes free and the request for approval can be transferred to the Environment Administration for processing.

PLEASE NOTE: If you do not click on the TRANSFER box, your request will not be transmitted to the Environment Administration!

> Subsequently, you will receive several emails/notifications confirming the progress of your request (acknowledgment of receipt, admissibility, inadmissibility, additional information, refusal, agreement).

IN CASE OF REFUSAL: From the date indicated on the refusal letter, your company is considered

non-compliant. If your company continues to sell non-household EEE and/or automobile/industrial batteries/accumulators in Luxembourg after this date and despite the refusal of individual approval, criminal sanctions and/or administrative measures will be initiated, in accordance with the amended Law of March 21, 2012 relating to waste.

IN CASE OF AGREEMENT: The ministerial approval is valid for a period of five years and contains the provisions with which you must comply. In the event of non-compliance with these provisions, your ministerial approval will be withdrawn. From the date indicated on the withdrawal order, your company is considered non-compliant. If your company continues to sell non-household EEE and/or automotive/industrial batteries/accumulators in Luxembourg after this date and despite the withdrawal of your individual approval, criminal sanctions and/or administrative measures will be initiated, in accordance with the amended Law of March 21, 2012 relating to waste.
