Information sheet for teaching staff

Thank you for choosing an activity from our school programme. Here is some important information to ensure that the excursion runs smoothly.



- Our guides and nature educators look forward to accompanying your class to the Biodiversum, the Haff Réimech nature reserve or the surrounding area. Their role is to guide and impart knowledge, as well as to lead the activity. Please note that during the activity, the teacher must continue to ensure the safety of the pupils and that the rules set by the nature guide are followed.
- It is also the teacher's responsibility to ensure that the children are dressed appropriately for the weather conditions. Our excursions also take place in rainy and cold weather, and some activities include games that involve contact with the ground and soil. In this regard, each child must wear a waterproof jacket, waterproof trousers (Bullisbox) and waterproof shoes.
- For activities lasting more than 2 hours, a picnic can be arranged, which the children bring themselves. For all activities, children must have a bottle of water in their bags. Please note that our main mission is to raise children's awareness of environmental protection. We would therefore be grateful if you could avoid using plastic as much as possible during the picnic.
- Our nature guides would be delighted if teaching staff could actively participate in the activity and thus set an example for the pupils. Please refrain from using your mobile phone during the excursion (except for class photos).
- You are welcome to bring your own binoculars.
